


1 INTIMACY

2 AUDACITY

"Audacity" can be defined as the courage to think big, a willingness to show initiative and take risks while facing the possibility of failure.

Gen 37:5 NLT

Likeability can also be defined as possessing the attractive attitudes and relational skills that causes others to want to work with you.

4 CAPACITY

5 RELIABILITY

"Reliability" can be defined as earning the trust of others by always keeping your promises and fulfilling your responsibilities even if it requires sacrifice.

Gen 39:6 NLT

6 So Potiphar gave Joseph complete administrative responsibility over everything he owned. With Joseph there, he didn't worry about a thing except what kind of food to eat! –

6 LOYALTY

"Loyalty" can be defined as being faithful to your boss and God when difficulty tests your commitment.

Gen 39:7-9 NLT

7 Joseph was a very handsome and well-built young man, and Potiphar's wife soon began to look at him lustfully. "Come and sleep with me," she demanded. 8 But Joseph refused. "Look," he told her, "my master trusts me with everything in his entire household.
